

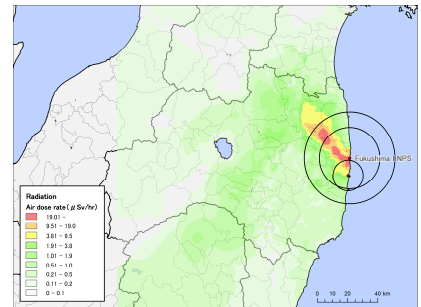
THE **TOHOKU** GEOGRAPHICAL ASSOCIATION



The **Tohoku Geographical Association** is an academic society for promoting geographical study and education, established in 1947 at Sendai, the center of **Tohoku** that means Northeast Japan. Rooted locally in Tohoku, it has grown to not only a nationwide but also a semi-global association consisting of more than 700 members including scores of colleagues outside Japan. Many papers covering all the area of geography are read in regular conferences held in spring and autumn, and are published in a bulletin, *Quarterly Journal of Geography*. The papers, written mostly in Japanese with English abstract, provide attractive and basic information of active and leading geographical researches in Tohoku, Japan and the World.
